Research shows that Big Brothers Big Sisters' mentoring program is the single most effective way to help vulnerable youth achieve success and reach their potential. Compared to others their age, boys and girls who are matched with a Big Brother or a Big Sister are:

- 46% less likely to begin using illegal drugs
- 27% less likely to begin using alcohol
- 52% less likely to skip school

- 33% more confident in their school performance
- 40% less likely to get arrested
