Program Description

- Follow guided curriculum to foster conversation
- Communicate once a week with your mentee via a secure online platform
- Meet with your mentee virtually once a month
- Support students with activities such as: FAFSA, budgeting and goal setting
- Receive continuous support from Match Support Specialists

Requirements

- Minimum 21 years of age
- Make a minimum one school year commitment
- Have at least 2 years of college experience, advanced licensure, or equivalent professional experience
- Able to pass a criminal background check
- Complete training prior to being matched with a mentee





What's going to be different?

- Due to COVID all activities will be virtual
- Mentees and mentors will be facing added stress of losing social outlets and worries due to the virus
- Students will have virtual classroom settings
- Virtual match events for mentors and mentees held once a month
